PICNIC NEWS CONTINUED

The benches on the new aluminum picnic tables in 2021 did not cover the length of the tables, limiting our seating capacity. We will be bringing some folding chairs to complement the new tables. At one end of each table is a provision for wheelchairs. If not used, we can put three chairs at that particular end. We will place the new tables back to back, which will allow a lot more seating for the picnic.

A special thank you to the alumni who showed up early to assist in the table alignment and setup. We will need the same assistance in 2022. I expect the minimum donation amount for 2022 to be kept at \$5. However, it will be appreciated due to higher costs if you can donate more. In 2023 we may be forced to increase the minimum donation. It really depends on the attendance in 2022. The picnic was initially funded from the Class of 1964 reunion fund and has been self-funding since 2015.
